



SEND Identification Pathway

Cause for Concern
Make SENCO aware and they will make a note on Scholarpack under child's name in Support Log. SENCO will include areas of concern given.

Inform parents/carers of your concern.
Work together to create a supportive Environment for the child both at home and at school.

Add meeting/phone call with parents/carers on to Scholarpack under Support Log and include meeting notes.
What is the outcome of the meeting?
See SENCO to gain advice on strategies.
The child will be monitored for 4 weeks and the education staff will use strategies to support the pupil.

After 4 weeks the SENCO will check in with education staff and see if we need to move forwards with referrals. A referral may be completed earlier than the 4 weeks due to long waiting lists.

Has the child started to make progress?
It is important to communicate with parents/carers at this stage because if a child is not making progress they will be placed on SEN Support.

YES?
Continue to provide personalised learning through Quality First Teaching and monitor closely.

No?
Continue to provide enhanced personalised learning, following strategies and advice from a range of professionals and complete the graduated approach using APDR for at least 2 terms before an EHC Needs Assessment is discussed.
