Attendance Week: Monday 6th October – Friday 10th October

This week is Attendance Shop Week!

Attendance rates have been good for the start of this year which is good news as one of the areas that we are still working hard to improve is attendance. Last year, our whole school attendance was only 94.9% which, although was above the national average, is below the government target of 96.0%. We are sad that we still have not yet been able to get our attendance levels back to the great levels we had before the covid pandemic.

As you are aware, there are now much stricter rules in force regarding attendance and we have to comply by these. This includes fining for holidays taken in term time and for absences which are unauthorised by the school. We are pleased that the vast majority of our children do attend school regularly. We will continue to work closely with families to support good attendance for all our children.

All children who attend school every day the week of the 6th – 10th October, will be able to visit the Attendance Shop.

Parent/Carer Consultations

There will be an opportunity for you to meet with your child's class teacher during the **week beginning 13th October**. You will have a chance to look at your children's work and discuss how they have settled into their new classes. Individual Educational Action Plans will also be shared with parents of children on the SEN register during these meetings. A further letter will be sent out at the end of next week so that appointments can be made.
